Home banking payment instructions:

1. **Log** into your bank or online bill pay website.
2. **Add** the new payee: NYC DOF Property Tax. Enter your account number, which is your boro, block and lot, as it appears here: 1-00384-0012 . You may also need to enter the address for the Department of Finance. The address is P.O. Box 680, Newark NJ 07101-0680.
3. **Schedule** your online payment using your checking or savings account.

When you provide a check as payment, you authorize us either to use information from your check to make a one-time electronic fund transfer from your account or to process the payment as a check transaction.



If you own income-producing property, you must file a Real Property Income and Expense (RPIE) statement or a claim of exclusion unless you are exempt by law. You must also file information about any ground or second floor commercial units on the premises, even if you are exempt from filing an RPIE statement. The deadline to file is July 1, 2020. RPIE filers whose properties have an actual assessed value of \$750,000 or greater will be required to file an addendum containing rent roll information. The deadline to file this addendum is September 1, 2020. Failure to file will result in penalties and interest, which will become a lien on your property if they go unpaid. Under New York City Housing Maintenance Code Article 4, Subchapter 2, the HPD-Property Registration Fee must be paid and the appropriate form must additionally be submitted to the Department of Housing Preservation and Development (HPD) in order to complete the required annual property registration for this property and have the building validly registered with HPD.
