NEW LAW: To learn about Local Law 147, which requires residential buildings with three or more units to create a policy on smoking and share it with current and prospective tenants, visit www.nyc.gov/health/tobaccocontrol.

If you own income-producing property, you must file a Real Property Income and Expense (RPIE) statement or a claim of exclusion unless you are exempt by law. You must also file information about any ground or second floor commercial units on the premises, even if you are exempt from filing an RPIE statement. The deadline to file is July 1, 2020. RPIE filers whose properties have an actual assessed value of \$750,000 or greater will be required to file an addendum containing rent roll information. The deadline to file this addendum is September 1, 2020. Failure to file will result in penalties and interest, which will become a lien on your property if they go unpaid.
